TORONTO, ONTARIO; Field Recreation Inc., a division of NUSTADIA Recreation Inc., has partnered with the Toronto District School Board to develop a field recreation facility to serve the greater Toronto area (GTA). The Lakeshore Collegiate Institute (LCI) Sports Centre operates year round. It is used by Lakeshore Collegiate during the day and the community during the evenings and weekends. The facility is located at 290 Birmingham St. in Etobicoke.

Along with organized league play, drop in soccer time is scheduled so that anyone can participate. The cost is \$10 per person. Adult time is available Monday Nights from 9 pm to 11 pm and on Thursdays and Fridays from 10 pm to midnight. Youth time for ages 12 to 16 is available on Saturdays from 6 pm to 8 pm. Special events like birthday parties or company team building programs focusing on field activities are also welcome.

The LCI Sports Centre features an air supported structure that is the ideal place for indoor play. It was erected for the first time in the fall of 2012 and has already been nicknamed, "The Bubble." The play area is covered with state-of-the-art Field Turf surface augmented by new technology lighting for night play. The Dome field measures 200 x 300 feet reaches 60 feet at its highest point. It can be split into 3 smaller fields.

The Bubble was opened in November, 2012. Anchoring partners include Etobicoke Youth Soccer Club, Toronto Services Soccer League, Toronto Lynx Soccer Club, Royal York FC, Toronto High Park FC, Toronto Pro Soccer League, Islington Rangers Soccer Club, Power Soccer and the Mimico Minor Lacrosse Club. Programs include Soccer, Field Lacrosse, Football, Baseball, Ultimate Frisbee, Drop-in soccer and Rugby.
